IT IS AGREED

1. In offering this agreement SCNA intends to:

- a) Include the umpire on the Umpires Roster for games conducted by SCNA between 1 January 2014 and 31 December 2014
- b) Provide an Umpires Roster in advance for competition games
- c) Pay per game according to Badge held *
- d) Arrange Clinics and rules discussions
- e) Provide Assessments and Coaching throughout the year
- f) Place Umpires on the final series of games according to merit and assessment by Umpire's Sub-Committee

2. In signing this agreement, the Badged Umpire agrees to:

- a) Maintain Umpiring education by attending Clinics as required by SCNA
- b) Be continually assessed and coached as required during 2014
- c) Umpire according to the AANA Rule Book and SCNA 'local rules' (see over)
- d) Present punctually to umpire on such dates and times as scheduled
- e) Behave in a professional manner in regards to appearance and attitude
- f) Be a financial member of Netball Queensland. **

Badged Umpires (18yrs & over) will be paid and extra \$5 per game for Mixed games

****Membership Fees:**

Non Playing Umpires Fees are \$30.00 for payment of the Netball Queensland Fee which covers Registration, Accident & Public Liability Insurance.

Please note if you are a non playing umpire, your registration fee will be deducted from your first pay and continue to be deducted until the Registration Fee is paid in full.

Whilst all umpires are expected to Umpire as per the AANA Rule Book there are also **a few local domestic rules which apply to SCNA competitions**: -

Uniforms – Players uniforms must be identical in style and colour. *Clubs/Teams* with permission to play out of uniform will have 'uniform exemption' marked on their score sheet by the Competition Co-ordinator. Permission to allow a player, without an exemption, to play is at the discretion of the Umpires & Comp Co-ord. Please note on the back of the score sheet whenever teams have a player/s out of uniform & the action taken.

Fingernails – must be cut short not taped. Gloves may be worn.

Jewellery – No item of jewellery except a wedding ring shall be worn and it must be taped. All body studs must be removed – no taping allowed.

Commencement of Competition Matches/Forfeits – Once time has been set by the Competition Co-ordinator teams will be allowed up to 5 minutes, as timed by the co-ordinator, to field a team so that games may go ahead. After 5 minutes has elapsed a forfeit may be declared by the Umpires. A social game may be arranged up until the end of the first quarter. Rostered Umpires must umpire the social game.

Score Sheets – All team members who take part in any match must sign the score sheet prior to taking the court. It is the **responsibility of the umpire** to check that the **number of signatures** on the score sheet corresponds with the **number of players** who played, check the final score then once satisfied that all is in order **print your name & place your signature on the score sheet**.

Scorers – Each team must supply a scorer for their game. **Scorers must score together** on the official score sheet. Scorers must keep an accurate record of all goals scored, all unsuccessful shots & record centre passes. (Only call centre pass if appealed to by the umpire.) Should a team not supply a scorer, that team must accept the score as recorded on the official score sheet. Should there be no scorers for any part of the game **the official score accepted will be that recorded from the time scorers are available**.

Umpires Duties – Umpires must wear clothes distinct from those of the players preferably white in colour. Club uniforms are not allowed. The Umpire must be available to the team captain during an interval or after a game for clarification of any rule.

Injury Time – Does not apply during SCNA competition games ie no extra time is added to the game. Injury time for semi-finals, finals and grand finals, of up to two (2) minutes per injury shall be allowed and added to the quarter in which the injury occurred. The Umpire shall request an official or responsible person to note the time.

Injuries – Umpires are to make a written report of any injuries, which occur during a match, on the back of the score sheet and sign as a witness.

Spectator Barracking – Encouragement in general terms is permitted. The team may be penalised by the umpire if unduly loud or boisterous calling to players, by coaches or spectators, continues during the game. Please report any harassment of umpires, players & spectators for further action.

Send offs – Umpires must report, on the back of the score sheet immediately such match as ended, any player or players she/he has sent from the court for any length of time and for any reason,. This report will be submitted to the Umpires Sub-Committee and the Executive Committee for further action as required.

Unavailable to umpire per roster - Umpires must contact the Umpires Co-ordinator, **at least 6 hours & no less than 2 hours prior to scheduled games**, should they be unavailable to umpire.

Forfeits – in the event of a forfeit the Umpire Co-ordinator will attempt to place you on a different game at the same time slot.
